This means one stud worn in the lower part of each ear lobe as a pair. The earrings can only be of a 'straight post' design and discreet in size. No form of hoop can be worn. No other piercings are allowed. If you need any clarification, please contact the school.
- Make -up – If worn must be subtle and natural in colour. No nail varnish/ gel or false nails.
- Hairstyles – Extreme hairstyles or unnatural colours are not permitted. Fully shaven heads and fully shaven parts or shaved patterns or lines in hair or eyebrows are not permitted. If religious headwear is worn, it must be plain black or navy blue. Hair accessories if worn should be subtle and black or navy blue.
